



Serbisyo ng Healthcare Identifiers – Humihiling ng Individual Healthcare Identifier (MS003)

Kailan gagamitin ang form na ito

Gamitin ang pormularyong ito kung ikaw (o nakadependeng (mga) anak ay mas bata 14 na taong gulang) ay kailangang kumuha ng Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) at:

- hindi ka marapat sa Medicare, o
- hindi ka marapat sa isang pensyon o benepisyo mula sa Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA).

Ang mga indibidwal na 14 na taong gulang pataas ay maaaring humiling ng kanilang sariling IHI gamit ang form na ito.

Mahalagang impormasyon

Tatanggap ka ng isang liham upang ipaalam sa iyo ang kinalabasan ng iyong aplikasyon.

Healthcare Identifiers Service

Ang Serbisyonang HI ay isang sistema na nagbibigay ng di pabago-bagong hanay ng mga identifier (pagkakakilanlan) para sa mga indibidwal at mga provider ng pangangalagang pangkalusugan. Ang mga identifier ng pangangalagang pangkalusugan ay isang paraan upang maitugma ang tamang tala sa taong ginagamot. Pinabubuti nito ang kawastuhan kapag ibinabahagi ang impormasyong pangkalusugan sa pagitan ng mga provider ng pangangalagang pangkalusugan.

Healthcare identifier

Ang healthcare identifier ay isang natatanging 16 na itinalagang numero at ginagamit upang makilala ang lahat ng mga nauugnay sa pangangalagang pangkalusugan sa Australya.

Walang klinikal na impormasyon ang naka-ugnay sa identifier. Hindi mo kailangang tandaan ang iyong IHI upang makatanggap ng pangangalagang pangkalusugan.

Kung ang IHI ay hinihiling para sa isang tao na wala pang 14 na taong gulang, maaari itong likhain gamit ang address ng magulang o tagapag-alaga.

My Health Record

Ang My Health Record ay isang online na buod ng impormasyon sa kalusugan ng isang indibidwal. Maaari itong ma-access ng indibidwal at ng kanilang mga provider ng pangangalagang pangkalusugan anumang oras. Maaari kang makakuha ng My Health Record matapos mong makuha ang iyong IHI.

Katibayan ng pagkakakilanlan

Dapat kang magbigay ng **1** sertipikadong dokumento mula sa Pangunahing pangkat o **2** sertipikadong dokumento mula sa Pangalawang pangkat para sa bawat tao na nag-aaplay para sa isang IHI. Ang mga pangalan sa mga dokumentong ito ay dapat magkapareho. Ang mga dokumentong ibinigay ay dapat pangkasalukuyan sa oras ng aplikasyon.

Kung ikinakabit mo ang mga dokumentong ito, ang mga kopya na ibinigay ay dapat sertipikado. Para sa impormasyon kung paano masesertipikahan ang mga dokumento, pumunta sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/hi

Primaryang grupo

- Pasaporte ng Australya
- dayuhang pasaporte o dokumento sa paglalakbay na may saysay na visa ng Australya
- lisensya sa pagmamaneho ng Australya
- kard ng pagkakakilanlan na may larawan na ipinalabas ng pamahalaang Commonwealth, estado o teritoryo

- mga dokumento na inisyu ng pamahalaang banyaga (halimbawa, mga lisensya sa pagmamaneho)
- may larawang lisensiya ng security guard/crowd control
- pang-konsuladong may larawang ID na inisyu ng DFAT
- dokumento ng pagkakakilanlan na may larawan ng isang mag-aaral sa tersiyaryo sa Australya
- dokumento ng pagkakakilanlan na may larawan ng isang mag-aaral sa sekundaryo sa Australya
- sertipikadong pang-akademikong transcript mula sa isang pamantasan sa Australya
- kard ng bangko o institusyong pampinansyal sa Australia

Healthcare Identifiers Service – Request an Individual Healthcare Identifier (MS003)

When to use this form

Use this form if you (or a dependent child(ren) under 14 years of age) need to get an Individual Healthcare Identifier (IHI) and:

- are not eligible for Medicare, or
- you are not eligible for a pension or benefit from the Department of Veterans' Affairs (DVA).

Individuals 14 years of age and over can request their own IHI using this form.

Important information

You will receive a letter to let you know the outcome of your application.

Healthcare Identifiers Service

The HI Service is a system that provides a consistent set of identifiers for individuals and healthcare providers. Healthcare identifiers provide a way to match the correct record to the person being treated. This improves accuracy when health information is shared between healthcare providers.

The *Healthcare Identifiers Act 2010* is available at www.legislation.gov.au

Healthcare identifier

A healthcare identifier is a unique 16 digit number that is assigned and used to identify everyone associated with healthcare in Australia. No clinical information is linked to the identifier. You do not need to remember your IHI to receive healthcare.

If an IHI is being requested for a person under 14 years of age, it will be created using the address of the parent or guardian.

My Health Record

A My Health Record is an online summary of an individual's health information. It can be accessed at any time by the individual and their healthcare providers. You can get a My Health Record after you get your IHI.

Evidence of identity

You must provide **1** certified document from the Primary group or **2** certified documents from the Secondary group for each person applying for an IHI. The names in these documents must be identical. Documents provided must be current at time of application.

If you are attaching these documents, the copies provided must be certified. For information about how to certify documents, go to servicesaustralia.gov.au/hi

Primary group

- Australian passport
- foreign passport or travel document with valid Australian visa
- Australian driver licence
- photo identification card issued by the Commonwealth, state or territory government
- Australian birth certificate or birth extract

Secondary group

- Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) issued United Nations convention travel document
- foreign government issued documents (for example, driver licences)
- security guard/crowd control photo licence
- consular photo identity card issued by DFAT
- Australian tertiary student photo identity document
- Australian secondary student photo identity document
- certified academic transcript from an Australian university
- Australian bank or financial institution card
