We have made it easier for you to find out about My Aged Care services.

We can help you with:

- starting your aged care journey
- accessing aged care services
- looking for help at home
- entering an aged care home.

## Aged Care Specialist Officers

In some of our service centres we have a free service to give you extra help you with your aged care questions. You, your family or a representative may be able to speak to one of our Aged Care Specialist Officers. They can help you by:

- giving information on the different types of aged care services
- checking if you can get government-funded services and making a referral for an aged care assessment
- providing financial information about aged care services
- helping you appoint a representative for My Aged Care
- connecting you to local support services.
