



Get proof of your COVID-19 vaccinations

Your International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate provides proof of your COVID-19 vaccinations.

The International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate is a secure record of vaccinations for people travelling internationally. We developed it to meet agreed international travel standards.

You can get your international certificate online if any of these apply:

- you have a current Australian passport
- you are an Australian dual citizen with a current Australian passport and a foreign passport
- you have a foreign passport with an Australian visa.

You must have had at least one dose of an approved or recognised COVID-19 vaccine.

You will need to request your international certificate when you plan to travel and before you go to the airport. This makes sure your international certificate is up to date. You need to allow up to 10 days for your most recent COVID-19 vaccinations to be recorded on the Australian Immunisation Register.

When planning a trip you should check:

- the entry and vaccination requirements of the country you are visiting
- and
- the travel requirements for the airlines you are travelling with.

Being up to date with your COVID-19 vaccinations means you have had all doses recommended for your age and health needs.

Your vaccination provider needs to report your COVID-19 vaccinations to the Australian Immunisation Register before you can get your international certificate.

If your name does not match what is on your passport, you may need to call the Australian Immunisation Register on 1800 653 809 Monday to Friday 8 am to 5 pm.

How to request your international certificate

The easiest way to get an International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate is online, using either:

- your Medicare online account through myGov
- the Express Plus Medicare mobile app.

If using Medicare online account through myGov:

1. Sign in to myGov.
2. Select **Go to Medicare** on the Proof of COVID-19 vaccination quick link.
3. Select **Request a certificate**.
4. Select **name** and then **Next**.
5. Follow the steps to verify vaccinations and passport details. You may need to update your middle name or family name in the passport details screen to match what is on your passport.

You can download or print a copy of your international certificate for your records.

If you are eligible for Medicare and do not yet have your Medicare online account linked to myGov:

- Select **Link Medicare** and follow the prompts to link Medicare online account to myGov.

There are 2 Medicare guides available in 21 languages:

- Link Medicare to myGov using a linking code
- Link Medicare to myGov using a Medicare card

If using the Express Plus Medicare mobile app:

1. Select Proof of vaccinations from Services.
2. Select Request a certificate.
3. Select your name, and then Next.
4. Follow the steps to verify the vaccinations and passport details. You may need to update your middle name or family name in the passport details screen to match what is on your passport.

You can save a copy of the international certificate by either:

- adding it to your digital wallet
- saving it to offline files in the app.

If you are not eligible for Medicare

You can use the Individual Healthcare Identifiers service (IHI service) through myGov:

1. Sign in to your myGov account.
2. Select **IHI service** from Your services.
3. Select View proof.
4. Select Request an international certificate, then Next.

Follow the steps to verify vaccinations and passport details. You may need to update your middle name or family name in the passport details screen to match what is on your passport.
