



Malipo kwa wanafunzi

Services Australia hutoa msaada wa kifedha kwa wanafunzi wanaostahili. Malipo hayo yanajumuisha Youth Allowance na Austudy.

Malipo kwa watu wa umri wa miaka 24 au wadogo zaidi

Youth Allowance ni malipo kwa watu wa umri wa miaka 16 hadi 24 wanaosoma wakati wote au kufanya Uanagenzi wa Australia wakati wote. Watu wengi wanatakiwa kusubiri hadi wanapomaliza shule ya sekondari au kufikia umri wa miaka 18 kabla wanapoweza kuomba kupata Youth Allowance. Kabla wanafunzi wanapofika umri wa miaka 18, wazazi wao wanaweza kupata Family Tax Benefit.

Malipo kwa watu wa umri wa miaka 25 au zaidi

Austudy ni malipo kwa watu wa umri wa miaka 25 au zaidi wanaosoma wakati wote au kufanya Uanagenzi wa Australia wakati wote.

Nyongeza kwa watu wanaopata malipo mengine

Pensioner Education Supplement ni malipo ya kusaidia kwa gharama za masomo. Hii ni kwa wanafunzi wanaopata malipo kutoka ama:

- Services Australia
- Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Mkopo kwa wanafunzi wengine

Student Start-up Loan ni mkopo wa hiari kwa wanafunzi wengine wa wakati wote wanaopata Youth Allowance au Austudy. Mkopo haulipwi kiatomati. Wanafunzi wanahitaji kuuomba. Wanafunzi wanahitaji kulipa mkopo mara tu wanapoanza kupata kiasi fulani cha mapato.

Malipo kwa kuhama

Wanafunzi wengine wanaopata Youth Allowance wanaweza pia kupata Relocation Scholarship. Hii inalipwa mara moja kwa mwaka. Inapatikana kwa wanafunzi wanaohitaji kuishi mbali kutoka nyumba yao ya familia ili kusoma.

Malipo kwa wanafunzi wa mikoa wanaohamia ili kusoma

Tertiary Access Payment ni malipo ya mara moja tu. Hii ni kwa wanafunzi wengine kutoka maeneo ya mikoa au ya mbali ya Australia. Inasaidia kwa gharama ya kuhamia ili kusoma baada ya shule ya sekondari.

Malipo kwa watafutaji kazi na watu wengine

Education Entry Payment inalipwa mara moja kwa mwaka. Inasaidia na gharama za kufanya masomo au mafunzo. Watu wanaopata malipo mengine kutoka Services Australia, ikijumuisha JobSeeker Payment, wanaweza kuipata.

Msaada mwingine

Wanafunzi wanaopata Youth Allowance, Austudy au Pensioner Education Supplement huenda pia kuweza kupata msaada mwingine. Kwa mfano:

Msaada wa gharama za usafiri

Fares Allowance husaidia na gharama za usafiri kwa wanafunzi wengine wanaohitaji kuishi mbali ya nyumbani ili kusoma.

Makubaliano na posho

Wanafunzi huenda pia kuweza kupata faida nyingine kama vile Health Care Card au Rent Assistance.

Kwa habari zaidi

- Piga simu kwenye laini ya Youth and Students (Vijana na Wanafunzi) kwenye **132 490**. Tujulishe ikiwa unahitaji mkalimani, na tutapanga mmoja bila malipo.
- Nenda kwa servicesaustralia.gov.au/education kupata habari zaidi katika Kiingereza.
- Nenda kwa servicesaustralia.gov.au/yourlanguage ambapo unaweza kusoma, kusikiliza au kutazama habari katika lugha yako.
- Piga simu kwa **131 202** kuongea nasi katika lugha yako kuhusu malipo na huduma za Centrelink.
- Piga simu kwa **132 011** kwa Medicare na **131 272** kwa Child Support. Tujulishe ikiwa unahitaji mkalimani, na tutapanga mmoja bila malipo.
- Tembelea kituo cha huduma.

Kumbuka: simu kutoka simu yako ya nyumbani kwenda nambari za '13' kutoka popote nchini Australia zinatozwa kwa kiwango kamili. Kiwango hicho kinaweza kutofautiana kutoka bei ya simu ya mtaa na kinaweza pia kutofautiana na watoa huduma wa simu. Simu kwa nambari za '1800' kutoka simu yako ya nyumbani ni bila malipo. Simu kutoka simu za umma na za mkononi zinaweza kupimwa kwa muda wao na kutozwa kwa kiwango cha juu zaidi.

Kanusho

Habari iliyomo katika chapisho hili linakusudiwa tu kuwa mwongozo kwa malipo na huduma. Ni wajibu wako kuamua ukitaka kuomba kwa malipo na kufanya ombi kuhusiana na hali yako maalum.



Payments for students

Services Australia provides financial help to eligible students. These payments include Youth Allowance and Austudy.

Payment for people aged 24 or younger

Youth Allowance is a payment for people 16 to 24 years of age who are studying full time or doing a full-time Australian Apprenticeship. Most people need to wait until they finish secondary school or turn 18 years of age before they can apply for Youth Allowance. Before students turn 18 years of age, their parents may get Family Tax Benefit.

Payment for people aged 25 or older

Austudy is a payment for people 25 years of age or over who are studying full time or doing a full-time Australian Apprenticeship.

Supplement for people getting other payments

The Pensioner Education Supplement is a payment to help with the costs of study. It is for students who get a payment from either:

- Services Australia
- Department of Veterans' Affairs.

Loan for some students

The Student Start-up Loan is a voluntary loan for some full-time students who get Youth Allowance or Austudy. The loan is not paid automatically. Students need to apply for it. Students need to pay the loan back once they start earning a certain amount of income.

Payment for relocating

Some students getting Youth Allowance can also get the Relocation Scholarship. This is paid once a year. It is available to students who need to live away from their family home to study.

Payment for regional students who move for study

The Tertiary Access Payment is a one off payment. It is for some students from regional or remote areas of Australia. It helps with the cost of moving to study after secondary school.

Payment for job seekers and other people

The Education Entry Payment is paid once a year. It helps with the costs of doing study or training. People who get some payments from Services Australia, including JobSeeker Payment, may get it.

Other help

Students who get Youth Allowance, Austudy or the Pensioner Education Supplement may also be able to get other help. For example:

Help with the costs of travel

Fares Allowance helps with the costs of travel for some students who need to live away from home to study.

Concessions and allowances

Students may also be able to get other benefits such as a Health Care Card or Rent Assistance.
