When to use this form

Use this form to apply for **initial grandfather** PBS-subsidised daratumumab for patients with newly diagnosed systemic light chain amyloidosis who have received non-PBS-subsidised treatment with daratumumab for the same condition prior to 1 January 2023.

Important information

Initial grandfather applications to start PBS-subsidised treatment can be made in real time using the **Online PBS Authorities** system or in writing and must include sufficient information to determine the patient's eligibility according to the PBS criteria.

Under no circumstances will phone approvals be granted for systemic light chain amyloidosis **initial grandfather** authority applications.

Continuing treatment

This form is ONLY for **initial grandfather** treatment.
