Visa and Migration System

This measure provides permanent residency to people on a:

- Temporary Protection visa, subclass 785 (TPV), or
- Safe Haven Enterprise visa, subclass 790 (SHEV).

Affected visa holders will move to a Resolution of Status visa, subclass 851 (RoS).

The RoS is available for people who held or applied for a TPV or SHEV before 14 February 2023. RoS visa holders will have access to a number of government services and benefits. Read more about [what support you can get on a RoS visa](#).

Services Australia will administer Australian Government payments and services as the new residents become eligible for them.

This measure is led by the Department of Home Affairs. Services Australia has been allocated \$61,000 for financial year 2022-23 to support eligible visa holders. A total of \$8.2 million will fund this measure through to the 2026-27 financial year.

This measure is subject to legislation passing.

Who this measure affects

This affects people currently on Temporary Protection visa (TPV subclass 785) or Safe Haven Enterprise visa (SHEV subclass 790).

When this starts and finishes

This started on 13 February 2023 and is ongoing.
