## Reforms to Migrant and Refugee Settlement Services

This measure will implement a client-centric program to improve settlement service delivery for refugees.

Current humanitarian settlement service arrangements expire in June 2024. This measure establishes a reform to Australia's humanitarian settlement services. It will promote better economic and social outcomes for refugees, earlier in their settlement journey.

Services Australia will implement a new Humanitarian Integration and Settlement Program (HISP) which is being led by the Department of Home Affairs.

This measure also extends Medicare eligibility for Ukrainian nationals granted a Bridging Visa E (BVE) by the Department of Home Affairs on or after 1 August 2022. This includes their immediate non-Ukrainian family members. Access to Medicare will extend for a further 3 years, from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2027.

This Medicare eligibility is granted through a Ministerial Order under the *Health Insurance Act 1973*.

This measure will apply to up to 1,200 eligible Ukrainian nationals during the 3 year period.

This measure will also allow Services Australia to support the reformed HISP and extended Medicare eligibility for Medicare through:

- website content
- forms
- internal guidance for Services Australia staff.

This measure isn't subject to legislation passing.

## Who this measure affects

This affects refugees settling into Australia.

## When this starts and finishes

This measure starts on 1 July 2023 and ends on 30 June 2025.

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
