



Ugovor o socijalnom osiguranju između Australije i Njemačke

Australski sustav socijalnog (mirovinskog) osiguranja

Australski sustav socijalnog (mirovinskog) osiguranja je različit od sustava većine drugih zemalja. Sve mirovine isplaćuje Australian Government (Australaska vlada) iz općih fondova, a ne iz doprinosa koji se uplaćuju u fond za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje. Iz tog razloga, australske mirovine podliježu testu prihoda i imovine.

Ako želite podnijeti zahtjev za australsku mirovinu, morate nam prijaviti sav vaš, te ukoliko imate partnera i njegov/njezin ukupan prihod.

Na koji način vam pomaže ovaj ugovor?

Ako živite u Australiji, u Njemačkoj ili u drugoj zemlji s kojom postoji ugovor⁵, ugovor vam obično omogućuje da podnesete zahtjev za australsku ili njemačku isplatu. Ugovor vam također omogućuje da saberete razdoblja boravka u Australiji i razdoblja socijalnog (mirovinskog) osiguranja u Njemačkoj kako biste ispunili minimalne uvjete za isplatu.

Australske isplate

Mi donosimo sve odluke o australskim isplatama.

Tko može dobiti australsku isplatu?

Kako biste imali pravo na isplatu prema odredbama ugovora, obično morate ispuniti sljedeće osnovne uvjete:

Australska isplata	Osnovni uvjeti:
Age Pension (Starosna mirovina)	• morate biti u dobi u kojoj imate pravo na mirovinu (posjetite servicesaustralia.gov.au/agepension za pojedinosti), i • ukupna dužina Australian residence (boravka u Australiji)² i razdoblje/a osiguranja u Njemačkoj mora/ju iznositi najmanje 10 godina.
Disability Support Pension (Invalidska mirovina)	• morate imati invaliditet ili trajno sljepilo, i • invaliditet/sljepilo je moralo nastati dok ste živjeli u Australiji. ILI • morate imati invaliditet ili trajno sljepilo, i • ukupna dužina Australian residence (boravka u Australiji)² i osiguranja u Njemačkoj mora iznositi najmanje 10 godina.
Carer Payment (Isplata za skrbnika)	• morate pružati skrb puno radno vrijeme, i • morali ste ranije živjeti u Australiji.
Parenting Payment (Dječji dodatak)	• vaš partner je umro, i • vi vodite brigu o jednom djetetu ili o više djece mlađe od 14 godina koja su ranije bila u Australiji, i

Australska isplata	Osnovni uvjeti:
	• ukupna dužina Australian residence (boravka u Australiji)² i osiguranja u Njemačkoj mora iznositi najmanje dvije godine.
Double Orphan Pension (Mirovina za dvostruko siroče)	• vi vodite brigu o mladoj osobi, i • mlada osoba je postala siroče dok je živjela u Australiji.

Napomene:

- Moguće je da ćete morati ispuniti dodatne uvjete kako biste dobili isplatu.
- Ako živite izvan Australije kada podnosite zahtjev, obično morate imati najmanje 12 mjeseci Australian Working Life Residence (radnog vijeka provedenog u Australiji)², od kojih 6 mjeseci mora biti bez prekida.
- Ne možemo biti sigurni hoćete li dobiti isplatu dok ne podnesete zahtjev i dok ne razmotrimo vaše okolnosti. Vi sami morate odlučiti hoćete li podnijeti zahtjev za isplatu ili ne.

Kako trebam podnijeti zahtjev za australsku isplatu?

Australiji	Za obrazac: • trebate imati myGov račun povezan s vašim Centrelink online account, (Internetski račun Centerlink-a) ili • isprintajte i popunite obrazac <i>Claim for Age Pension and Pension Bonus (Zahtjev za starosnu mirovinu i bonus uz mirovinu)</i> sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/sa002 i obrazac <i>Income and Assets (Prihod i imovina)</i> sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/sa369, ili • nazovite našu službu za usluge starijim građanima Australije - Older Australians line⁴. Kako ćete predati zahtjev: • unesite ga preko myGov, ili • obrazac i sve popratne dokumente nam možete poslati poštom⁴ ili osobno ih predati u vama najbližem Services Australia Service Centre.
Njemačkoj	Za obrazac: • kontaktirajte Njemački zavod za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³ • nazovite - International Services line⁴, (našu službu za međunarodne usluge) ili • isprintajte i popunite obrazac <i>Claim for Australian pension from an agreement country (Zahtjev za australsku mirovinu iz zemlje s kojom postoji ugovor)</i> sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/aus140 i obrazac <i>Income and Assets (Prihod i imovina)</i> sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/mod-ia Kako ćete predati zahtjev: • odnesite obrazac i sve popratne dokumente u bilo koji ured njemačkog socijalnog (mirovinskog) osiguranja³.

Drugoј zemlji s kojom postoji ugovor⁵	Za obrazac: • nazovite - International Services line⁴ (našu službu za međunarodne usluge), ili • isprintajte i popunite obrazac <i>Claim for Australian pension from an agreement country (Zahtjev za australsku mirovinu iz zemlje s kojom postoji ugovor)</i> sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/aus140 i obrazac <i>Income and Assets (Prihod i imovina)</i> sa servicesaustralia.gov.au/mod-ia
	Kako ćete predati zahtjev: • podnesite obrazac i sve popratne dokumente u bilo kojem uredu socijalnog osiguranja u toj zemlji.

Zahtjevi za australske isplate se obično mogu podnijeti 13 tjedana unaprijed. Obrazac zahtjeva i sve popratne dokumente morate predati istodobno. Ako to ne uradite, zahtjev može biti odbijen.

Njemačke isplate

Njemački zavod za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje donosi sve odluke o njemačkim isplatama. Za daljnje informacije o njemačkim isplatama, kontaktirajte Njemački zavod za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³.

Tko može dobiti njemačku isplatu?

Ako želite saznati možete li dobiti njemačku isplatu prema odredbama ugovora, posjetite internetske stranice njemačkog zavoda za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³.

Australiji	Za obrazac: • nazovite - International Services line⁴ (našu službu za međunarodne usluge).
	Kako ćete predati zahtjev: • podnesite obrazac i sve popratne dokumente u vama najbližem uredu Services Australia Service Centre, ili • pošaljite nam poštom zahtjev i sve popratne dokumente⁴.
Njemačka	Za obrazac: • slijedite naputke na internetskim stranicama Njemačkog zavoda za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³, ili • kontaktirajte Njemački zavod za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³.
	Kako ćete predati zahtjev: • slijedite naputke na internetskim stranicama Njemačkog zavoda za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³, ili • podnesite obrazac i sve popratne dokumente u bilo kojem uredu Njemačkog zavoda za socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje³.

1. Definicija partnera	Smatramo da imate partnera ako živite s drugom osobom kao (bračni) par. Smatramo da živite s drugom osobom u paru ako ste: • oženjeni/udani • u registriranoj vezi • u vanbračnoj vezi (de-facto). Registrirana veza je veza koja je registrirana prema zakonu jedne od australskih država ili teritorija. Ako ste svoju vezu registrirali izvan Australije, tu vezu ne priznajemo kao registriranu. To vam može biti dokaz da živite u vanbračnoj vezi. Vanbračna veza je veza slična bračnoj vezi, samo što niste vjenčani, niti ste registrirali vezu.	
2. Australian residence/Australian Working Life Residence (Boravak u Australiji / Boravak u Australiji za vrijeme radnog vijeka)	„Australian residence' (Boravak u Australiji)' znači razdoblja u kojima ste boravili u Australiji kao australski državljanin ili ste bili nositelj australske vize za stalni boravak. Australian residence (boravak u Australiji) u bilo kojem trenutku se koristi za stjecanje prava na australsku isplatu. „Australian Working Life Residence (Boravak u Australiji za vrijeme radnog vijeka) je / su samo razdoblje/a boravka u Australiji između dobi od 16 godina i dobi za Age Pension.	
3. Na koji način možete kontaktirati njemačko socijalno (mirovinsko) osiguranje	Sustav socijalnog osiguranja u Njemačkoj temelji se na doprinosima koje stranka uplaćuje u okviru programa. Postoje 3 fonda:

Social Security Agreement between Australia and Germany

Australia's social security system

Australia's social security system is different to most other countries. Each person's pension is paid by the Australian Government out of general funds, rather than through contributions paid into a social insurance fund. For this reason, Australian pensions are income and asset tested.

You will have to tell us about all of your, and if you have a partner¹, your partner's¹ income and assets if you want to claim an Australian pension.

How does the agreement help you?

If you live in Australia, Germany or another specified agreement country⁵, the agreement generally allows you to submit a claim for an Australian or German payment. It also allows you to add together your periods of residence in Australia and periods of social security coverage in Germany, so you can meet any minimum requirements for payment.

Australian payments

We make all decisions about Australian payments.

Who can get an Australian payment?

To qualify under the agreement, you generally need to meet the following basic requirements:

Australian payment	Basic qualifications:
Age Pension	• you must have reached the qualifying age (refer to servicesaustralia.gov.au/agepension for details), and • your total Australian residence² combined with your period(s) of coverage in Germany must add up to at least 10 years.
Disability Support Pension	• you must have a disability, or be permanently blind, and • your disability/blindness occurred while you were living in Australia. OR • you must have a disability, or be permanently blind, and • your total Australian residence² combined with your period of coverage in Germany must add up to at least 10 years.
Carer Payment	• you must be providing full-time care for someone, and • you must have lived in Australia before.
Parenting Payment	• your partner must be deceased, and • you must be caring for one or more children under 14 years of age who has been to Australia before, and • your total Australian residence² combined with your period(s) of coverage in Germany must add up to at least 2 years.

Australian payment	Basic qualifications:
Double Orphan Pension	• you must be caring for a young person, and • the young person must have become an orphan while they were an Australian resident.

Notes:

- There may be additional requirements you need to meet before you can be paid.
- If you live outside Australia when you claim, you generally need at least 12 months Australian Working Life Residence², of which 6 months must be in one period.
- We cannot be sure if you will get a payment, until you submit a claim and your circumstances are taken into account. It is your responsibility to decide whether you submit a claim for payment or not.

How do I claim an Australian payment?

If you are in:	
Australia	To get a claim form: • you need a myGov account linked to your Centrelink online account, or • print and complete a <i>Claim for Age Pension and Pension Bonus</i> form from servicesaustralia.gov.au/sa002 and the <i>Income and Assets</i> form from servicesaustralia.gov.au/sa369, or • call us on the Older Australians line⁴.
	To lodge a claim form: • upload via myGov, or • you can give your claim form and any supporting documents to us by mail⁴ or by visiting your nearest Services Australia Service Centre.
Germany	To get a claim form: • contact the German social insurance agency³ • call us on the International Services line⁴, or • print and complete a <i>Claim for Australian pension from an agreement country</i> form from servicesaustralia.gov.au/aus140 and an <i>Income and Assets</i> form from servicesaustralia.gov.au/mod-ia
	To lodge your claim form: • take your claim form and any supporting documents to any German social insurance agency office³.
Another specified agreement country⁵	To get a claim form: • call us on the International Services line⁴, or • print and complete a <i>Claim for Australian pension from an agreement country</i> form from servicesaustralia.gov.au/aus140 and an <i>Income and Assets</i> form from servicesaustralia.gov.au/mod-ia

If you are in:	
	To lodge your claim form: • take your claim form and any supporting documents to any social insurance agency office in that country.

Claims for Australian payments can generally be submitted up to 13 weeks early. You must submit your claim form and *all supporting documents* at the same time. If you do not do this your claim may not be accepted.

German payments

The German social insurance agency makes all decisions about German payments. For more information about German payments, you should contact the German social insurance agency³.

Who can get a German payment?

To see if you can get a German payment under the agreement, you will need to refer to the website of the German social insurance agency³.

How do I claim a German payment?

If you are in:	
Australia	To get a claim form: • call us on the International Services line⁴.
	To lodge your claim form: • take your claim form and any supporting documents to your nearest Services Australia Service Centre, or • return your claim form and any supporting documents to us by mail⁴.
Germany	To get a claim form: • follow any instructions on the website of the German social insurance agency³, or • contact the German social insurance agency³.
	To lodge your claim form: • follow any instructions on the website of the German social insurance agency³, or • take your claim form and any supporting documents to any German social insurance agency office³.

Footnote	Information	
1. Definition of a partner	You have a partner if we consider you a member of a couple. We consider you a member of a couple if you're: • married • in a registered relationship • in a de facto relationship. A registered relationship is where your relationship is registered under a law of an Australian state or territory. If your relationship is registered outside Australia, we do not recognise it as a registered relationship. You can use it as evidence for a de facto relationship. A de facto relationship is where you and your partner are in a relationship similar to a married couple but are not married or in a registered relationship.	
2. Australian residence/Australian Working Life Residence	'Australian residence' means periods when you were living in Australia as an Australian citizen or Australian permanent visa holder. Australian residence at any time is used to qualify for an Australian payment. 'Australian Working Life Residence' is period/s of Australian residence between the ages of 16 and Australian Age Pension age only.
