When to use this form

Use this form if you are an education provider and need a course assessed to determine ABSTUDY eligibility.

Important information

An ABSTUDY approved course needs to satisfy the requirements of Chapter 11 'Approved Courses of Study' of the ABSTUDY Policy Manual.

Receiving ABSTUDY

Your answers will determine if a student can receive ABSTUDY and if an education institution can receive ABSTUDY on the student's behalf (for example, ABSTUDY Away from Base assistance). We will also assess if the course is eligible for Away from Base funding from the National Indigenous Australians Agency (NIAA) (for example, a tertiary level mixed-mode course), as the course also needs to be an ABSTUDY approved course.

Away from Base activities

Away from Base activities are necessary academic parts of an approved course that require students to travel away from their home or study location for a short period of time.

Away from Base activities include:

- on-campus residential schools (also known as block release programs) for students who are normally completing their course externally (by distance education or online) at their home location
- practical or professional placements or field trips that require students to travel away from their home.
