**Moneysmart's Simple money manager** is a free online budgeting tool to help people who speak languages other than English to manage their money day-to-day.

The tool lets users look at money coming in (income) and going out (expenses), so they can direct their money to where it matters most.

The simple money manager is available in English and eight other languages. These include established communities (Simplified and Traditional Chinese, Italian, Arabic, Vietnamese) and recently arrived groups (Somali, Dari and Sudanese Arabic).
