



Child Care Subsidy (Te buoka ibukin tararuaakia ataei)

Te Child Care Subsidy e buoka kauarerekean boon tararuaakia ataei n taabo n tararua ake a kariaiakaki. Ngkana e reke iroum te buoka aei, ao tina kabwaka te mwane nakon te tabo are e karaoa tararuaakia ataei bwa e aonga n uarereke te mwane ae ko na kabwaka ibukin tararuaan am ataei.

Ngkana ko kan karekea te Child Care Subsidy aio ao ko riai n iri nanon kainibaaire aikai:

- Ngkana akea kakoouaam man te tua ao ko riai n tararuaa te ataei ae 13 ana ririki ke iaana ae aki reirei nte kauarinan.
- ko kabonganaa te tabo n tararua ibukia ataei ae kariaiakaki ibukin tararuaakia ataei
- bon ngkoe ae kona tabena kabwakaan boon tararuaakin am ataei
- ko irii nanon tuua ibukin te tiku ni maeka ao tuan taian iti ibukin totokoan Aoraki.

Ko ira nanon te tua ibukin te maeka ngkana ngkoe ke raom kam bon maeka i Aotiteria ao iai mai buakomi ae e ira nanon teuana mai buakon baikai:

- Ae a bon riki raoi bwa kaain Aotiteria
- Ae iai kariaiakana bwa te tia tiku ni maeka ao ni mwakuri nte aba
- ae iai kariaiakana n roko nte aba iaan te Special Category
- ae iai kariaiakana n tiku tabeua te tai n aron te partner provisional ke kariaiakana iaan te temporary protection.

Ko kona naba n ira nanon te tua ni kamaeka ngkana iai iroum baikai:

- ngkoe ke raom bon ataein te reirei aika kam roko man aaba aika a raroa ao a mwanenaki reireimi i Aotiteria man te Australian Government
- Ko mena inanon te kainano ni kaitaraan te maiu ke baikara riki kanganga aika ko mena inanona

A kona n aki irekereke ma ngkoe tabeua man akana a oti aikanne bwa e nakon aron tein am kangaanga.

E na mwaitira te buoka nte Child Care Subsidy ae kona n reke iroum

Mwaitin te buoka man te Child Care Subsidy ae kona n reke iroum e tii reke ngkana a bane n iai baika inano aikai iroum:

- mwaitin am kareke mwane n am utu
- aia ririki ao mwaitiia ataei aika ko tararuaia ae a kabonganai taabo ibukin tararuaakia ataei
- tein ma aekakin te tabo ibukin tararuaakia ataei ae kariaiakaki ae ko kabonganaa
- Mwaitin te aoa ae kona n reke iai iroum te buoka aei e na boboto iaon tein taraakin am utu ma mwaitin ataakin am kakammwakuri ngkoe ma raom.

Ana karekemwane am utu

Ti na kabonganaa am karekemwane n am utu ni mwakuriabwa e na iraua te Child Care Subsidy ae kona n reke iroum.

Ko riai n anganira katautauan mwaitin ae ko karekea ni katoa ririki. Ti na kabonganaa am katautau aio ni mwakuriia bwa mwaitira te Child Care Subsidy ae na kabwakaaki ibukin buokan am ataei.

Mwaitin te Child Care Subsidy ae ko kona ni karekea e na kona n iai te bitaki nakoiai ngkana iai naba bitakin am karekemwane. E kakawaki bwa kona kaongoira bitakin am karekemwane bwa e aonga naba n eti raoi mwaitin ae na reke iai te Child Care Subsidy ibukin am ataei.

Ngkana e raka iaon temanna am ataei ae 5 te ririki ke iaana riki aika a mena iaan am tararua ao a kabonganai taabo n tararua ibukia ataei, e na iai rakan ana buoka te Child Care Subsidy ibukin temanna ke e nako riki iaomia am ataei

Rakan te Child Care Subsidy e aki irekereke ma mwaitin te In Home Care are e tararuaaki iai am ataei bon iaan mwengam ibukina ngke te In Home Care bon buokan te utu ao tiaki ibukia ataei. Te na ni kanga In Home Care e tei nabaia naba te aomata, tei naba te aomata ni karawa.

Te tia ni boo n te aoa

Te mwaiti ae kona n reke man te Child Care Subsidy e nakon aekakin te tabo ibukin tararuaakia ataei ae kariaiakaki ao roron am ataei.

Ti mwakuriia am Child Care Subsidy man katebubuan am karekemwane n am utu. Mwaitin te katebubua man am Child Care Subsidy e na nakon mwaitin te tiaati nte aoa are ko tiaatinaki iai ibukin tararuaan am ataei nte mwaiti ae mai nano. Te tia ni boo aio bon man ana babaire te tautaeka are e riirinanoaki ni katoa ririki.

Mwaitin te aoa ae na buokaki ibukin tararuaakia ataei

A bane ni kona utu nako ni karekea 72 te aoa ke e nako riki ae ana buokaki iai man te Child Care Subsidy ni katoa uoua te wiiki.

Ko kona ni karekea 100 te aoa ae buokaki iai tararuaan am ataei ni katoa uoua te wiiki ngkana iai teuana mai buakon aikai iroum:

- ngkoe ma raom (ngkana iai raom) kam kaai ni kaakabanea ae raka iaon 48 te aoa ni mwakuri n taian mwakuri aika a kinaaki ni katoa uoua te wiiki
- lai beeban kakoauaam man te tua ae riai n reke iai iroum te buoka aei.

Aikai aekakin taian mwakuri aika a kinaaki:

- te mwakuri ae ko kabooaki iai ae iai taian motirawa iai ao iai naba te motirawa ibukia aine ake a bikoukou ke ni bung
- karaoan te kamatebwai ke te reirei
- te mwakuri n ana karikirake te utu ae ko aki kabooaki iai
- ko tabe ni kakaea am mwakuri
- ko mwakuri n anganano

- Ko bon mwakuri ke ni karikirakea arom i bon iroum.

Ngkana iai raom ke buum, tina kabongana are e uarereke riki ana mwakuri mai buakomi ni mwakuriia iai mwaitin te aoa ae na buokaki iai tarauaan ami ataei.

Kam riai n teimatoa ni kaotii bibitakin tein ami mwakuri ngkoe ma raom bwa e aonga n reke raoi te mwaiti ni buoka ae eti man te Child Care Subsidy.

Te mwaiti ae na tauaki man are kabwakaaki ibukin am Child Care Subsidy

Ibukin kauarerekean reken te rake ni kabwakamwane ao e na taatauaki 5% man am Child Care Subsidy ni katoa uoua te wiiki. Ko kona ni bita te mwaiti aei nakon are ko kona ni kaitaraa.

Kabaerantan am kabwakamwane ma te Child Care Subsidy

Ni katoa banen ririkin te kabwakamwane, ao ti kakabaeranta am bwakamwane. Ti kaboowarea katautauan am karekemwane ma are bon oin am karekemwane. Aio e na buoka etin raoi te mwaiti are e riai ni bwaka imwin reken te buoka aio.

Ko riai ni kaota raoi am karekemwane nakoira bwa ti aonga ni kona ni karaoa aio ibukim. Ngkana iai buum ke raom ao e riai naba ni kakoauaaki raoi ana karekemwane. Ko kona ni karina mwin ana taumwane te tautaeka ibukin am makuri (tax returns) ke ni kaongoira ae aki riai karinakin mwiin taian taumwane aikai.

Ngkana am katautau n am karekemwane e uarereke nakon are bon am karekemwane raoi ao tina bae ni kabwaka buokam ae raka, ao ko riai ni kaoka ter aka anne. Ti na kabongana are ti taataua man am Child Care Subsidy ni buoka iai kauarerekean te mwaiti are ko riai ni kaokia.

Ngkana e raka am katautau n am karekemwane nakon are bon oin am karekemwane ao e na bae n aki tau am Child Care Subsidy, ao ti riai ni kakoroa te mwaiti anne nakoim. E na reke naba ibuakon aio te mwaiti are e taatuaki man am Child Care Subsidy.

Ibukin rongorongon kabaerantan te Child Care Subsidy riki ae bwanin nte taetae n imatang ao n taetae riki tabeua ao nakon servicesaustralia.gov.au/ccsbalancing

Additional Child Care Subsidy

Te Additional Child Care Subsidy e na anga te raka ni buoka nakoia tabeua utu ni boon tararuakia aia ataei. E na riai n tia n reke am Child Care Subsidy bwa ko aonga ni kona ni karekea te Additional Child Care Subsidy. Iai aekakin te buoka aio aika a kakaokoro aika ko kona ni kataa rakem iai:

- Additional Child Care Subsidy (grandparent). Aio ibukia tiibu ake a tararuakia tibuia ke tibutoruia. Ko kona ni karekea te buoka aio ngkana iai te kabwakamwane nakoim ae buokan am karekemwane.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (temporary financial hardship). Aio te buoka ae aki teimaan are bon buokam ngkana iai am kanganga n am karekemwane nte tai ae uarereke aika a riaon am kona n aron ae tao e bua am mwakuri, ke iai rotakin am mwakuri man taian angibuaka ke tao ngkana iai ae mate man am utu.

- Additional Child Care Subsidy (transition to work). Aio te buoka ibukim ngkana ko a kitana te kabwakamwane ibukin buokan am karekemwane ao ko nang waakina am makuri ke am reirei.

Iai naba te Additional Child Care Subsidy (child wellbeing) are ko kona ni karekea rongorongona man te tabo are tararuaaki iai am ataei. Aio te buoka ibukia utu ake a kai rotaki ke bon iai rotakiia nte kanganga. Aio are e kona karaoia ibukim am tabo are e karaoa te tararua nakoia am ataei.

Ko na kanga ni karekea te Child Care Subsidy ao te Additional Child Care Subsidy

Ko riai ni karaoa am akaunti ae arana myGov ao am akaunti naba iaon te Centrelink. Ana riai n toma raoi man irekereke am myGov ma am Centrelink akaunti.

Ngkana akea am myGov akaunti ao ko kona ni karaoia iaon **my.gov.au**

Ibukin buokam iaon karaoan am akaunti ae myGov, ko kona ni karaoia iaon **servicesaustralia.gov.au/mygovguides**

Kabongana am Centrelink akaunti rinanon myGov ni karekea iai am Child Care Subsidy, ma katauraoi baika a kainanoaki ibukin karekean anne iroum.

Ngkana ko aki kona ni karaoia ni kabonganaan te intanete ao tareboonira iaon **136 150** ibukin buokam. Ko aki kainanoa ae ko na nakon te tabo ni kareke buoka ibukin butan ke karekean te buoka aio.

Rongorongona riki tabeua

Ibukin am rongorongo: ao ko kona n tarebonia nambwa aika '13' iaon Aotiteria ma a bane ni kaboaki ni booia aika a tia ni katauaki. Te boo aio e kona ni kakaokoro teia imarenan taian tabo ake a karaoa te tieweti iaon te reitaki nte tareboon. Tareboonian te nambwa ae '1800' man mwengam a bon aki kabooaki. Tareboon man taian tabo n tareboon ke man am 'mobile' tareboon a bon bane n tainaki ao a kabooaki nte boo ae raka riki.

Tiaki tabera

Rongorongo ni kabane aika a oti ikai a bon tii karaoaki bwa kairan kawai ibukin bwakamwane ma waaki ni ibuobuoki. Bon tabem n rineia bwa kona kataa karekean te bwakamwane ae irekereke ma tein am konaa ni kaitarai am kangaanga.



Child Care Subsidy

Child Care Subsidy helps with the cost of approved child care. If you can get it, we will pay it directly to your child care provider to reduce the fees you pay.

To get Child Care Subsidy, you must meet all of the following:

- care for a child aged 13 or younger who is not in secondary school, unless you have an exemption
- use an approved child care service
- be the person responsible for paying the child care fees
- meet residence and immunisation rules.

To meet the residence rules, you or your partner must be living in Australia and have one of the following:

- Australian citizenship
- a permanent residence visa
- a Special Category visa
- a certain temporary visa type, for example, a partner provisional or temporary protection visa.

You may also meet the residence rules if any of the below apply:

- you or your partner are an overseas student, sponsored by the Australian Government to study in Australia
- you are in hardship or special circumstances apply.

Some of these points may not apply to you in certain situations.

How much Child Care Subsidy you can get

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get depends on all of the below:

- your family's income
- the age and number of children in your care using child care
- the type of approved child care you use
- the hours of subsidised care you are eligible for based on your family's circumstances and recognised participation you and your partner do.

Family income

We will use your family income to work out the amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get.

You need to give us an income estimate each financial year. We use this estimate to calculate how much Child Care Subsidy to pay your child care service.

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get may change if your income changes. To make sure you get the right amount of Child Care Subsidy, you need to update your estimate if your income changes.

Families with more than one child aged 5 or under

If you have more than one child aged 5 or under in your care using child care, you may get a higher rate of Child Care Subsidy for one or more of your children.

The higher Child Care Subsidy rate does not apply to In Home Care sessions of care, where the child is being cared for in their home. This is because In Home Care is subsidised for the family, rather than for each child.

Hourly rate cap

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get will depend on the type of approved child care you use and the age of your child.

We work out your Child Care Subsidy percentage using your family income estimate. Your Child Care Subsidy percentage will apply to either the hourly fee you are charged by your child care service or the hourly rate cap, whichever is lower. The hourly rate cap is a rate set by the government and reviewed each year.

Hours of subsidised child care

All families eligible for Child Care Subsidy can get at least 72 hours of subsidised child care each fortnight.

You can get 100 hours of subsidised child care each fortnight if either of the following apply:

- you and your partner (if you have one) each do more than 48 hours of recognised participation every fortnight
- you have a valid exemption.

Recognised participation types can include:

- paid work – including leave, like maternity leave
- study and training
- unpaid work in family business
- looking for work
- volunteering
- self-employment.

If you have a partner, we'll use the lower of your or your partner's recognised participation to work out your hours of subsidised child care.

To make sure you get the right amount of Child Care Subsidy, you need to check and update your recognised participation if your or your partner's situation changes.

Holding back part of your Child Care Subsidy payment

To help reduce the chance of an overpayment, we will withhold 5% of your Child Care Subsidy each fortnight. You can change the amount we withhold to suit your circumstances.

Balancing your Child Care Subsidy payment

At the end of each financial year, we balance your payments. We do this by comparing your income estimate to your actual income. This will make sure you got the correct amount of subsidy.

You need to confirm your income for us to do this. If you had a partner, their income must also be confirmed. This can be done by lodging tax returns or by you telling us tax returns don't need to be lodged.

If your income estimate is lower than your actual income, we may have paid you too much subsidy which you will need to pay back. We will use the Child Care Subsidy we withheld to reduce the amount you have to pay back.

If your income estimate is higher than your actual income and you did not get enough Child Care Subsidy, we will pay any outstanding amount directly to you. This will include the Child Care Subsidy we withheld.

Additional Child Care Subsidy

Additional Child Care Subsidy gives extra help to some families with their child care fees. You must already get Child Care Subsidy to be able to get Additional Child Care Subsidy. There are different types you can apply for:

- Additional Child Care Subsidy (grandparent). This is for a grandparent, or great grandparent with primary care of your grandchild or great grandchild. To get it, you must get an income support payment.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (temporary financial hardship). This gives short-term help if you are in temporary financial hardship due to things you cannot control. This can include if you have lost your job, been affected by a major disaster event or experience the death of a partner or child.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (transition to work). This helps if you are moving from an income support payment by starting work, study or training.

There is also Additional Child Care Subsidy (child wellbeing) which you can ask your child care service about. This helps vulnerable or disadvantaged families and children. Your child care service will need to apply for you.

How to claim Child Care Subsidy and Additional Child Care Subsidy

To make a claim online, you need a myGov account and a Centrelink online account. Your myGov account must be linked to Centrelink.

If you do not have a myGov account, go to my.gov.au to create one.

Use your Centrelink online account through myGov to claim Child Care Subsidy, provide your information and any supporting documents.

If you cannot claim online, call us on **136 150**. You do not need to go to a service centre to make a claim.

Check how much Child Care Subsidy you can get

You can use the Child Care Subsidy Calculator to see what your Child Care Subsidy rates may be and how much you may pay for child care. Go to startingblocks.gov.au
