



Child Care Subsidy (Puok Dogin Eoning)

Child Care Subsidy buoga pumwen bita eoning. Tsin ia wa gona in bitune, ama nan buogun pumwe amebina dabein ranga bita eoning dogun enim redodu eken pumwen.

Gona en bitune Child Care Subsidy, wa nim arowonga memak mungane:

- ranga en bina eoning 13 aura eobweni oa eoning eken ngea etiok egoda secondary, ita ia waeo tengeij
- owunon ko bita buoget eoning service
- enim awe engame ion ngea gona iwudoduwa pumwe et eoning.
- enim arowonga dogorin megum me ranga en tsimorum

Enim arowonga dogorin ina, awe oa amea/eita dangom wanim mek ian Australia me enim tsimine bet mungane:

- enim awe ngamen Australia
- enim tsimine wam permanent residence visa
- bita Special Category visa
- bita certain temporary visa type, tekeij, partner provisional oa temporary protection visa

Wa nan arowonga bet bita dogorit emek ina tsin ia muguraw mungane:

- awe oa amea/eita dangom ngea kereri ian Australia, ngea pumwe eow turun Australian Government
- awe ia wo tuk iat ekeiyeya oa ia tuk iat imwit inon ekae ken.

Imin mungane epan gona bet eo arowonga imin ngana eo towew.

Ngabet puok ngea wa nan gona dōgin Child Care Subsidy

Bitu ngaben Child Care Subsidy awe gona, pe ean memak mungane:

- ngaben wam muk
- an obweni me ebakin eoning bina mek ian bem me wa owunon bitune ranga et eoning, child care (rangaet eoning)
- bita deiden ranga et eoning, child care (rangaet eoning) awe owunon
- bita hour n ranga et eoning ngea oijaw pe ean deiden tsimorum megun amen bwim, me emakur ngea wa riring, awe me amea/eita dangom.

Wan muk amen bwiom

Ma nan owunon bita wam muk bwe ma nim makur ean bita ngaben Child Care Subsidy awe nan gona.

Wa nim pana kama bita ngabet emuk awe amatu iat eobweni. Ama owunon bitune ngaben wam muk bwe ma nim tsied egen ngaben Child Care Subsidy enim pumwe ean wam child care service (buoken rangaet eoning).

Bitá ngábet emuk Child Care Subsidy oijaw inan gona kiwiwud tsin ia tsimine an kiwiwud wam income. Tsin ia enim emwi ngábet emuk atsin turun Child Care Subsidy, wo gona pana kama bitá ngáben wam muk tsin ia kiwiwuden.

Bitá an roga pumwen Child Care Subsidy eo arowonga an ewaw In Home Care, ino meg me ranga bitá eoning. Ngea dogun, In Home Care, eij buoken bwita aiqwen family me eo ea aiqwen eoning.

Hour’n Magur

Ngábet ipuok dogun Child Care Subsidy nan oijaw, inan pe ean bitá deiden “ranga et eoning (child care)” awe owunon me bitá an obweni ngaim.

Ama makur ean wam Child Care Subsidy ean ama owunon me kabeij wan muk amen bwim. Gaben wam muk’n Child Care Subsidy inan mugura bitá pumwen am hour ngea oijaw atsin turun wam ranga et eoning oa bitá pumwen’t hour, tamo ion earur ngea redodu iken. Bitá ngábet e hour eij pumwen ion ngea amamo eow turut edogor me aea iat eobweni.

Hour’n bitá rangaet eoning

Memak amen bwini bina ijij dogin Child Care Subsidy nan gona pumwe ean ura 72 hour dogin ranga et eoning (child care) ia daeit kamaramwi.

Wa nan gona 100 hour ean ranga et eoning (child care) ia daeit kamaramwi tsin ia wa edegeri ion ean mungane:

- awe me dangom (tsin ia tsimine) ouwak iken ea 48 hour pumwe emur ian amur makur
- tsin ia wa eo tengeij

Imin ngana gonan buoku ean tekei:

- pumweiw ean am makur – tekei anano ngea wat enamon
- Ekereri me kererieyen am makur
- eo pumweiw ean wan business amen bwim
- kanani emakur
- puok
- tawe makuraw

Tsin ia tsimine dangom, ama nan owunon bitá an redodu am hour n mugur oa amea/eita dangom me ma nan mugureij bitá wam hour n ranga eoning (child care).

Tsin ia wa teng tsit ia emwi ngábet emuk Child Care Subsidy oijaw, wa nim eodogin aea me pana kama tsin ia awe oa amea/eita dangom etsimine an kiwiwud pumwe emur.

Rangaen wam Child Care Subsidy me pumwen

Dugit eobweni eanuww, inan aea me weimin memak an ememari wam muk. Amwa iriring ngune eow ean ababo en owununen wam muk atsin damonin dogun enim eimi memak riringen mungane wam imin.

Wo nan aea me pana kama ngaben wam muk mwam gonan eriring ngune. Ia timine dangom, mwa inan teng bet tsied ngaben wan muk. Egona riring ngune ia amwa pana kama.

Ia onung iken wam muk ret metu ea ken bita kor gaben wam muk, gona dogun ouwak ngea mwa pumwew me ngagan, wo nan pumweyin kama. Mwa inan owunun bwita Child Care Subsidy ngea mwa babij, dogun enim onung iken ngea wo nim pumwe.

Ia ngea wam muk wo gona ouwaka iken ngaben kor wam muk turum, me eo eguna dogit Child Care Subsidy, mwa nan pumwewen awe. Inan pumwew epoa bet muk'n Child Care Subsidy ngea mwa babiji.

Additional Child Care Subsidy

Additional Child Care Subsidy etoto puok iken ea epon amin bwini dogun buoken dedein ngaira. Wo nim ogein gona bitune Child Care Subsidy ia wo nim tuk gonan bet Additional Child Care Subsidy. Etsimine me ebuk earut ngane mwane ia wo teng tekei:

- Additional Child Care Subsidy (grandparent). Ngune dogun ibum oa ibut ibum dogin rangaen ibun oa ibut ibun. Gonangen ngune, wo nim timine buogem.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (temporary financial hardship). Ngune oiyaw ipuok eat edae ken. timine okor am tageg me gonangin wam muk. Gona bet ia ekewen am magur, oa dogin an dukurae eb oa dogin ima amin bwiem or ngaim.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (transition to work). Ngune buoku ia erowin bitune ipuok me wo aweidan magur oa kereri.

Etsimine bet Additional Child Care Subsidy (child wellbeing) ngea wo gonan kudoij bet ura. Ngune buoken amin bwieni me eoning ngabina ar eo gonagon. Emebina wam child care service (buoken rangaet eoning) gonan riringaw ngune.

Etanamanin gonane bwita Child Care Subsidy me ia wò teng tuk gona bet ken ean bwita Additional Child Care Subsidy

Ia wò teng enim pumwew, enim timine wam myGov account me Centrelink online account. Me bwita wam myGov account enim arowonga ea Centrelink.

Ia ekeo wam myGov account, wo nan geidu na my.gov.au me beida wam ion.

Ipuok dogun dedein wam myGov account, wo nan geidua servicessaustralia.gov.au/mygovguides.

Wo owunun Centrelink iat internet eow ean owunonen myGov dogin gona en Child Care Subsidy, wo nan godauw wam dabuch ngana buokem.

Child Care Subsidy

Child Care Subsidy helps with the cost of approved child care. If you can get it, we will pay it directly to your child care provider to reduce the fees you pay.

To get Child Care Subsidy, you must meet all of the following:

- care for a child aged 13 or younger who is not in secondary school, unless you have an exemption
- use an approved child care service
- be the person responsible for paying the child care fees
- meet residence and immunisation rules.

To meet the residence rules, you or your partner must be living in Australia and have one of the following:

- Australian citizenship
- a permanent residence visa
- a Special Category visa
- a certain temporary visa type, for example, a partner provisional or temporary protection visa.

You may also meet the residence rules if any of the below apply:

- you or your partner are an overseas student, sponsored by the Australian Government to study in Australia
- you are in hardship or special circumstances apply.

Some of these points may not apply to you in certain situations.

How much Child Care Subsidy you can get

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get depends on all of the below:

- your family's income
- the age and number of children in your care using child care
- the type of approved child care you use
- the hours of subsidised care you are eligible for based on your family's circumstances and recognised participation you and your partner do.

Family income

We will use your family income to work out the amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get.

You need to give us an income estimate each financial year. We use this estimate to calculate how much Child Care Subsidy to pay your child care service.

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get may change if your income changes. To make sure you get the right amount of Child Care Subsidy, you need to update your estimate if your income changes.

Families with more than one child aged 5 or under

If you have more than one child aged 5 or under in your care using child care, you may get a higher rate of Child Care Subsidy for one or more of your children.

The higher Child Care Subsidy rate does not apply to In Home Care sessions of care, where the child is being cared for in their home. This is because In Home Care is subsidised for the family, rather than for each child.

Hourly rate cap

The amount of Child Care Subsidy you can get will depend on the type of approved child care you use and the age of your child.

We work out your Child Care Subsidy percentage using your family income estimate. Your Child Care Subsidy percentage will apply to either the hourly fee you are charged by your child care service or the hourly rate cap, whichever is lower. The hourly rate cap is a rate set by the government and reviewed each year.

Hours of subsidised child care

All families eligible for Child Care Subsidy can get at least 72 hours of subsidised child care each fortnight.

You can get 100 hours of subsidised child care each fortnight if either of the following apply:

- you and your partner (if you have one) each do more than 48 hours of recognised participation every fortnight
- you have a valid exemption.

Recognised participation types can include:

- paid work – including leave, like maternity leave
- study and training
- unpaid work in family business
- looking for work
- volunteering
- self-employment.

If you have a partner, we'll use the lower of your or your partner's recognised participation to work out your hours of subsidised child care.

To make sure you get the right amount of Child Care Subsidy, you need to check and update your recognised participation if your or your partner's situation changes.

Holding back part of your Child Care Subsidy payment

To help reduce the chance of an overpayment, we will withhold 5% of your Child Care Subsidy each fortnight. You can change the amount we withhold to suit your circumstances.

Balancing your Child Care Subsidy payment

At the end of each financial year, we balance your payments. We do this by comparing your income estimate to your actual income. This will make sure you got the correct amount of subsidy.

You need to confirm your income for us to do this. If you had a partner, their income must also be confirmed. This can be done by lodging tax returns or by you telling us tax returns don't need to be lodged.

If your income estimate is lower than your actual income, we may have paid you too much subsidy which you will need to pay back. We will use the Child Care Subsidy we withheld to reduce the amount you have to pay back.

If your income estimate is higher than your actual income and you did not get enough Child Care Subsidy, we will pay any outstanding amount directly to you. This will include the Child Care Subsidy we withheld.

Additional Child Care Subsidy

Additional Child Care Subsidy gives extra help to some families with their child care fees. You must already get Child Care Subsidy to be able to get Additional Child Care Subsidy. There are different types you can apply for:

- Additional Child Care Subsidy (grandparent). This is for a grandparent, or great grandparent with primary care of your grandchild or great grandchild. To get it, you must get an income support payment.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (temporary financial hardship). This gives short-term help if you are in temporary financial hardship due to things you cannot control. This can include if you have lost your job, been affected by a major disaster event or experience the death of a partner or child.
- Additional Child Care Subsidy (transition to work). This helps if you are moving from an income support payment by starting work, study or training.

There is also Additional Child Care Subsidy (child wellbeing) which you can ask your child care service about. This helps vulnerable or disadvantaged families and children. Your child care service will need to apply for you.

How to claim Child Care Subsidy and Additional Child Care Subsidy

To make a claim online, you need a myGov account and a Centrelink online account. Your myGov account must be linked to Centrelink.

If you do not have a myGov account, go to my.gov.au to create one.

For help setting up your myGov account, go to servicessaustralia.gov.au/mygovguides

Use your Centrelink online account through myGov to claim Child Care Subsidy, provide your information and any supporting documents.

If you cannot claim online, call us on **136 150**. You do not need to go to a service centre to make a claim.

Check how much Child Care Subsidy you can get

You can use the Child Care Subsidy Calculator to see what your Child Care Subsidy rates may be and how much you may pay for child care. Go to startingblocks.gov.au
