Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) (儿童牙科补助方案) 为 0-17 岁的儿童支付部分或全部基本牙科服务费用。

您可以访问 servicesaustralia.gov.au/childdental，了解我们覆盖的项目及补助金额。

如何确认 CDBS 资格

如果您的子女符合儿童 CDBS 申领资格，您将收到来自 Services Australia 的确认信函。

该资格有效期为 2 年。

儿童或青少年在符合以下条件时，可以获得 CDBS：

- 在日历年度内至少有一天年龄在 0-17 岁之间
- 已登记在 Medicare 卡上
- 其本人每年至少从 Centrelink 或 Department of Veterans' Affairs 领取一次符合条件的福利金；或其父母、看护人或监护人每年至少领取一次我们提供的相关福利金。

我们会根据您的 Centrelink 福利金信息和 Department of Veterans' Affairs 提供的信息，判断您是否可以获得 CDBS。

如何查询 CDBS 余额

您可以通过以下方式查询您孩子的 CDBS 余额：

- 咨询您的牙医
- 使用 myGov 手机应用程序
- 访问 my.gov.au，选择 Medicare，然后选择“History and statements”，再选择“Child Dental Benefits Schedule”
- 致电 **132 011**。如需传译服务，告知我们即可为您免费安排。

CDBS 覆盖范围

CDBS 覆盖的牙科服务包括：

- 检查
- X 光
- 清洁
- 补牙
- 根管治疗
- 拔牙。

CDBS 不覆盖以下服务：

- 牙科整形
- 美容牙科
- 任何在医院里提供的牙科服务。

CDBS 服务不会被计入 Medicare Safety Net。您可以访问 servicesaustralia.gov.au/medicare-safety-nets，了解更多关于 Medicare Safety Net 的信息。

如何使用 CDBS

预约牙医，并告知对方您享有 CDBS 资格。

在就诊时，牙医必须在开始治疗前向您说明您孩子需要的服务项目以及相关费用。若您同意，则需签署一份同意书。

CDBS 福利领取方法

如果您的牙医接受 **bulk bills**（全额报销），您无需提交报销申请。**Bulk billing**（全额报销）意味着您无需向医疗专业人员支付医疗服务费用。

如果您的牙医不接受 **bulk bill**，您需要先行向牙医支付费用，然后向我们申请报销。

您不能向 CDBS 和私人保险机构同时申领同一牙科服务的费用报销。

Child Dental Benefits Schedule

The Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) covers part or the full cost of some basic dental services for children aged 0 to 17.

You can go to servicesaustralia.gov.au/childdental to find out what and how much we cover.

How to know if you can get CDBS

You will get a letter from Services Australia if your child can get the CDBS.

It is valid for 2 years.

A child or teenager can get CDBS if:

- they are aged 0 to 17 years for at least one day of the calendar year
- they are on a Medicare card
- they are getting an eligible Centrelink or Department of Veterans' Affairs payment at least once a year, or have a parent, carer or guardian getting a payment from us at least once a year.

Information about your Centrelink payments and from the Department of Veterans' Affairs tells us if you can get CDBS or not.

How to check your CDBS balance

You can check the CDBS balance amount for your child by:

- asking your dentist
- using the myGov app
- going to **my.gov.au** and selecting Medicare then 'History and statements', then 'Child Dental Benefits Schedule'
- calling **132 011**. Let us know if you need an interpreter and we will arrange one for free.

What is covered under the CDBS

The CDBS covers services including:

- examinations
- X-rays
- cleaning
- fillings
- root canals
- extractions.

CDBS does not cover:

- orthodontic
- cosmetic dental work
- any dental services done in a hospital.

CDBS services do not count towards the Medicare Safety Net. You can go to **servicessaustralia.gov.au/medicare-safety-nets** to find out more about the Medicare Safety Net.

How to use the CDBS

Make an appointment with a dentist and let them know you get the CDBS.

At the appointment, the dentist must tell you what services your child needs and how much it will cost before they start. If you agree you will need to sign a consent form.

Claiming benefits under the CDBS

If your dentist bulk bills, you do not need to make a claim. Bulk billing means you do not have to pay for your medical service from a health professional.

If your dentist does not bulk bill, you need to pay the amount to the dentist and then claim your benefit from us.

You cannot claim a benefit under the CDBS and from a private health insurer for the same dental service.

Calls from public and mobile phones may be timed and charged at a higher rate.
