



# Tasmanian Freight Equalisation Scheme Manufacturers' and miners' application to register southbound goods (TAS025)

## When to use this form

Use this form if you are a registered manufacturer or miner and want to register southbound goods for the Tasmanian Freight Equalisation Scheme (TFES).

## Tasmanian Freight Equalisation Scheme

The TFES provides financial assistance to eligible businesses that ship eligible goods by sea across Bass Strait.

You must register with TFES **and** have your eligibility approved by Services Australia **before** submitting a claim for financial assistance.

To register, you **must** complete and submit the **Registration and change of details (TAS020)** form.

## Eligible southbound goods

To be eligible for financial assistance, the goods must be:

- raw materials or equipment used in your manufacturing or mining processes in Tasmania
- registered with Services Australia before claims are lodged.

Eligible southbound goods can be:

- **domestic goods** – produced or manufactured on the mainland of Australia or, if imported, have undergone a manufacturing process on the Australian mainland
- **imported goods** – imported from overseas and shipped to Tasmania from a mainland Australia port.
