



子女抚养费对 Family Tax Benefit 的影响

如果您正在领取 Family Tax Benefit（家庭税务补助金），且您与孩子的另一位家长已不再是伴侣关系，您可能需要申请 child support（子女抚养费）。

什么是子女抚养费

子女抚养费是指一位家长支付给另一位家长，用于分担抚养子女费用的款项。

即使父母双方没有伴侣关系，或者其中一方居住在海外，双方仍有责任承担抚养子女的费用。

当您申请子女抚养费后，我们会通知您和另一位家长，抚养费应由谁支付以及具体金额。

Services Australia 也可以为您代收这笔款项。

子女抚养费会如何影响您的 Family Tax Benefit

子女抚养费的支付与 Family Tax Benefit Part A（家庭税务补助金 A 部分）是关联的。

您领取的子女抚养费金额会影响您的 Family Tax Benefit Part A 金额。

如果您有与前伴侣所生的子女，并且正在领取 Family Tax Benefit，您必须在规定期限内申请子女抚养费。

在该期限后，如果您尚未申请子女抚养费，或尚未联系我们商讨您的可选方案，那么您领取的 Family Tax Benefit 可能会减少，直到您提出申请为止。

如果您因某些原因无法申请子女抚养费，请务必告知我们。

如何申请子女抚养费

如需申请子女抚养费，请致电 **131 272** 联系 Services Australia 的 Child Support 部门工作人员。

为了受理您的申请，我们需要核实孩子的亲生父母身份。我们可能会请您回答一些问题或提供相关文件。我们通常也需要和孩子的另一位家长沟通。

如果您无法申请子女抚养费

如果您因某些原因无法向孩子的另一位家长索要子女抚养费，请告知我们。原因可能包括：

- 文化原因
- 家庭暴力
- 申请子女抚养费让您感到不安全
- 其他涉及隐私的原因。

您需要与我们的社工交谈，并说明您无法申请子女抚养费的原因。

届时我们可以予您豁免，这样您便无需向另一位家长索要子女抚养费了。

How child support affects your Family Tax Benefit

If you get Family Tax Benefit and you are not in a relationship with the other parent of your child, you might need to apply for child support.

What is child support

Child support is money a parent pays to the other parent to help with the costs of looking after their child.

Both parents are responsible for the costs of bringing up a child even if they are not in a relationship or one of the parents lives overseas.

When you apply for child support, we will tell you and the other parent who needs to pay child support and how much to pay.

Services Australia can also collect this money for you.

How child support can affect your Family Tax Benefit

Child support payments and Family Tax Benefit Part A are linked.

The amount of child support you get can affect your Family Tax Benefit Part A.

If you have a child from a previous relationship and get Family Tax Benefit, you have a set time to apply for child support.

After this time, if you have not applied for child support or contacted us to talk about your options, you may get less Family Tax Benefit until you apply.

If there are reasons you cannot apply for child support, you need to let us know.

How to apply for child support

To apply for child support, you will need to call our Services Australia Child Support staff on **131 272**.

To accept your application, we need to check who the birth parents of the child are. We may ask you to answer some questions or give us some paperwork. We usually need to talk to the other parent too.

If you cannot apply for child support

You can let us know if there are reasons you cannot apply for child support from the other parent of your child. These can be:

- cultural reasons
- family and domestic violence
- if claiming child support makes you feel unsafe
- other reasons that are sensitive.

You will need to talk to one of our social workers and tell them why you cannot apply for child support.

We can then give you an exemption, so you do not need to ask for child support from the other parent.
