Recipients of Parenting Payment Partnered/Parenting Payment Single/Youth Allowance (other) who are determined to be current (i.e. entitled to be paid) on the Centrelink payment system.

Recipients of Sickness Allowance/ABSTUDY who are determined to be current (i.e. entitled to be paid) on the Centrelink payment system.

Recipients of Newstart Allowance who are determined to be current (i.e. entitled to be paid) on the Centrelink payment system and are not in receipt of CDEP Participation Supplement.

Recipients of Partner Allowance / Widow Allowance who are determined to be current (i.e. entitled to be paid) on the Centrelink payment system and are not in receipt of CDEP Participation Supplement or a zero rate of payment.

Commonwealth Electoral Divisions are based on the recipient's geo-coded address against the Australian Statistical Geography Standard (ASGS) 2011.
