



# Healthcare Identifiers Service Application to amend a Healthcare Provider record (HW034)

## When to use this form

Use this form to amend a Healthcare Provider Identifier-Individual (HPI-I) record within the Healthcare Identifiers (HI) Service.

You can use this form to remove, add or amend:

- personal details
- provider details
- a Healthcare Provider Directory (HPD) entry.

If you are registered with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (Ahpra) in your state or territory, you must contact Ahpra to update your details.

You can remove, add or amend contact details online through the Health Professional Online Services (HPOS). Read more about HPOS below.

## Healthcare Identifiers Service

The HI Service is a system that provides a consistent set of identifiers for individuals and healthcare providers. Healthcare identifiers provide a way for you to match the correct records to the person you are treating. You can include them in patient files, test results and other healthcare related information. This improves accuracy when you share health information with other healthcare providers. The *Healthcare Identifiers Act 2010* is available at [legislation.gov.au](http://legislation.gov.au)

## Healthcare Provider Directory

The Healthcare Provider Directory (HPD) is a directory of healthcare identifiers and business details for providers and organisations registered in the HI Service. Only individuals or organisations that are authorised can search the HPD for details.

You can search for contact, specialty and identifier details of other healthcare providers and organisations registered in the HI Service. This can be useful when you are sending secure messages, referrals, discharge summaries and patient test requests.

## Health Professional Online Services

Healthcare providers can do online business with Services Australia through HPOS, including selected HI Service functions.

Some functions you can do include:

- add and update contact details
- search for other healthcare providers and organisations in the HI Service.

## Provider Digital Access

You need a Provider Digital Access (PRODA) account to access HPOS. Designed as a 2-step verification process, it requires a username, password and verification code to login. Create your PRODA account at [servicesaustralia.gov.au/proda](http://servicesaustralia.gov.au/proda)

## Additional documents

### Identifying information

If you are changing identifying information such as your name, date of birth or gender, you will need to provide certified documentary evidence which supports your changes (for example, marriage certificate).

### Provider registration details

If you are updating provider registration details not covered by Ahpra, you will need to provide:

- evidence that you are registered by a registration authority as a member of a health profession or a member of a professional association (as defined by the *Healthcare Identifiers Act 2010*), and
- evidence of any new specialities required to be added to the provider record.

## Provider obligations under the *Privacy Act 1988*

You have obligations under the *Privacy Act 1988*, Schedule 3 - National Privacy Principles in relation to your patients' personal information. The *Privacy Act 1988* is available at [legislation.gov.au](http://legislation.gov.au)
