Nyiya employment income-ji

Employment income-ji maniyi yangka kuja kanpala mani nyuntu parnta jarrllu warrki jangka kajinparla employer-ku warrki jarrimi.

Nyiya gross employment income-ji

- Nyuntu nyangu gross employment income-ji ngulaju yangka amount maniyi kujangku nyuntu nyangu employer-rlu payi manu tax-ki ngarnti manu ngalya deductions jangka. Kapunpa information nyampuju nyanyi nyuntu nyangu payslip-rla.
- Ngarrika nganpa gross employment income kirli kajinpa mani.
- Nyuntu parnta kurlangu-langu income, kajinpa pala mardani palka.

Nyiya jangka yungurlipa milya pinyi information nyampuju

- Information nyampuju yangka kajilpanpa pay jarriyarla junga maniyi yangka debt wangu.
- Kajinpa debt mardani ngulaju kaji kanpa nganpa pina payi mani.
- Marda kaji karnalu yarda yirrarni maniyi yangka kajinpa employer kurlangu mani nyuntu nyangu online reporting task-kirra.
- Information nyampuju ka yanirni nyuntu nyangu employer jangka kuja ka yilyami Australian Taxation Office (ATO) kurra yangka Single Touch Payroll wana.

Nyiya Single Touch Payroll-ju

- Nyampuju yangka information kuja ka nyuntu nyangu employer-rlu yilyami ATO kurra manu kajana ngarriri nyajangu maniyi kuja kanpa mani.
- Kajili kuja jarrimi, nati jana yungka gross employment income yangka kujangkulu pay manu, ngarrika nganpa yangka kujaju junga japa jungarni amounts kurlu manu marda jungarni wangu.

 - Kajinpa wangkami help-ki yangka report maninjaku employment income-ji, ring-i mantalu nganpa **1800 136 380** kurra Monday to Friday **8am ngirli 5pm kirra**.
 - Kajinpa wangkami interpreter ku, kapurnalu mani jinta free-ki.
 - Ngampurrpa wangu help-kiji ring-manta nganpa **133 276 (13 EARN)** kirra **8am ngirli 5pm kirra** nyuntu nyangu reporting day-rla nyuntu nyangu employment income-ji.
 - Kajinpa nganpa ring-i mani yungka nganpa nyuntu nyangu Customer Access Number (CAN) manu Personal Identification Number yangka (PIN) lawangkaju 6 digit PIN wanguju ngulaju ring-i manta jana **136 240**, yungunpa jinta mani.

Reporting your employment income

What is employment income

Employment income is money you or your partner get from any work you do for an employer.

What is gross employment income

- Your gross employment income is the amount of money your employer pays you before tax and other deductions. You can find this information on your payslip.
- You must tell us the gross employment income you get.
- This also includes your partner's income, if you have one.

Why do we need this information

- We need this information to make sure you are paid the right amount of money and you do not get a debt.
- If you get a debt you will have to pay us back.
- Sometimes, we may prefill the money you get from your employer into your online reporting task.
- This information comes from reports your employer sends to the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) through Single Touch Payroll (STP).

What is Single Touch Payroll

- This is information that your employer sends to the ATO to let them know how much money you got paid.
- If this happens, you do not need to provide the gross employment income you were paid but you will need to let us know that these details are correct or give us the correct amounts if the amount is not correct.

How to report your employment income

You can report your employment income to us in different ways:

- at your local service centre
- online using your Centrelink online account through my.gov.au
- on the Express Plus Centrelink mobile app
- by telephoning us:
 - If you need help from us to report your employment income, call **1800 136 380** Monday to Friday **8 am to 5 pm**.
 - If you need an interpreter, we will provide one for free.
 - If you do not need help from us, call **133 276 (13 EARN)** between **8 am and 5 pm** on your regular reporting day to report your employment income.
 - When you call you will need to provide us with your Customer Access Number and Personal Identification Number (PIN). If you do not have a 6-digit PIN, call **136 240** to get one.
